From Hershey: follow Route 743 N. At Route 22, turn right and travel east approximately 13 miles. At traffic light turn right onto Rt 343. Follow 2 1/2 miles to Pine Meadow Road, near the Wetlands restaurant and Pine Meadows Golf Complex. Turn right onto Pine Meadow Road, then proceed 1 1/2 miles. Kenbrook is on the right and marked with a large sign at the entrance.

The Chief Inspector Armand Gamache book series is written by Louise Penny. Prior to writing full-time, she worked 20 years as a radio journalist and host for CBC Radio in Thunder Bay, Ontario & Winnipeg, Manitoba.

The series centers on the character of Chief Inspector Armand Gamache. Stories take place in the village of Three Pines, with Gamache investigating the murders of various people in each novel. They have been described as "character-driven" mysteries that explore the relationships between characters with each book in the series.

Three Pines is a fictional location set in the province of Quebec. Penny sets up the characters using the history of old Canada to show their personalities and backgrounds.

While it's helpful if you've read at least one book in the 13-book series, no advance reading is required by participants.

Leading this year's retreat are PC (USA) educators: Debbie Hough of Derry Presbyterian Church in Hershey, PA and Joyce MacKichan Walker and Carol Wehrheim of Nassau Presbyterian Church in Princeton, NJ. Joyce is a Canadian native.
